




Figure 5. Body Diode Forward Voltage Figure 6. Capacitance Characteristics Variation vs. Source Current and Temperature




Figure 7. Gate Charge Characteristics




Figure 8. Breakdown Voltage Variation vs. Temperature




Figure 9. On-Resistance Variation vs. Temperature




Figure 10. Maximum Safe Operating Area




Figure 11. Maximum Drain Current vs. Case Temperature




Figure 12. E_{OSS} vs. Drain-to-Source Voltage




Figure 13. Normalized Power Dissipation vs. Case Temperature




Figure 14. Peak Current Capability




Figure 15. R_{DS(on)} vs. Gate Voltage





Figure 16. Normalized Gate Threshold Voltage vs. Temperature




Figure 18. Transient Thermal Response




Figure 19. Gate Charge Test Circuit & Waveform




Figure 20. Resistive Switching Test Circuit & Waveforms




Figure 21. Unclamped Inductive Switching Test Circuit & Waveforms





Figure 22. Peak Diode Recovery dv/dt Test Circuit & Waveforms




