### DESCRIPTION

The TS3USB221A is a high-bandwidth switch specially designed for the switching of high-speed USB 2.0 signals in handset and consumer applications, such as cell phones, digital cameras, and notebooks with hubs or controllers with limited USB I/Os. The wide bandwidth (900 MHz) of this switch allows signals to pass with minimum edge and phase distortion. The device multiplexes differential outputs from a USB host device to one of two corresponding outputs. The switch is bidirectional and offers little or no attenuation of the high-speed signals at the outputs. It is designed for low bit-to-bit skew and high channel-to-channel noise isolation, and is compatible with various standards, such as high-speed USB 2.0 (480 Mbps).

The TS3USB221A integrates ESD protection cells on all pins, is available in a tiny  $\mu$ QFN package (2.0 mm  $\times$  1.5 mm) and is characterized over the free air temperature range from  $-40^{\circ}\text{C}$  to  $125^{\circ}\text{C}$ .

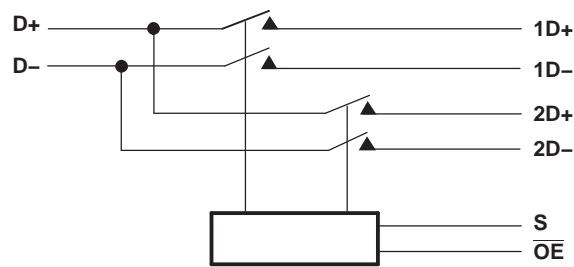
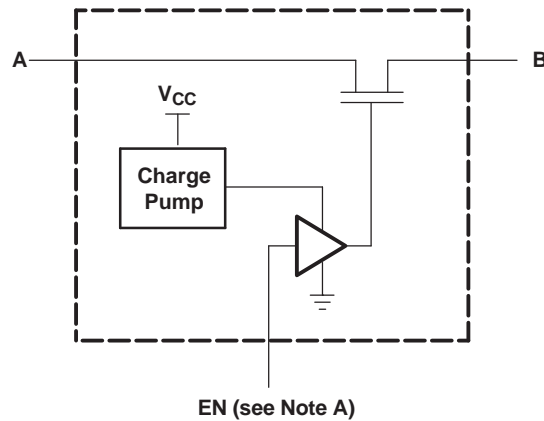


Figure 1. SIMPLIFIED SCHEMATIC, EACH FET SWITCH (SW)

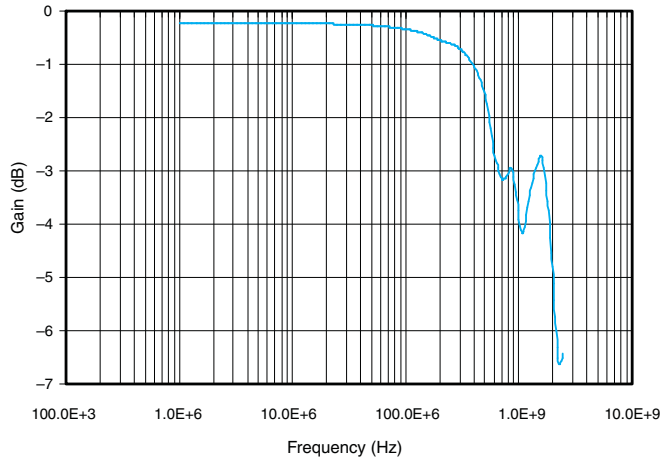


Figure 2. Gain vs Frequency

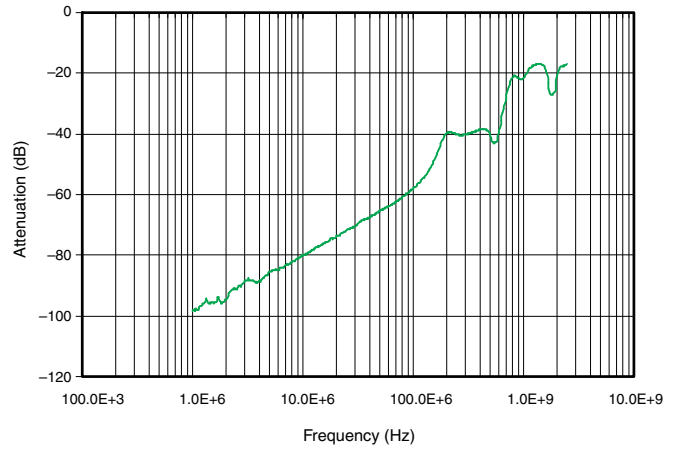


Figure 3. OFF Isolation vs Frequency

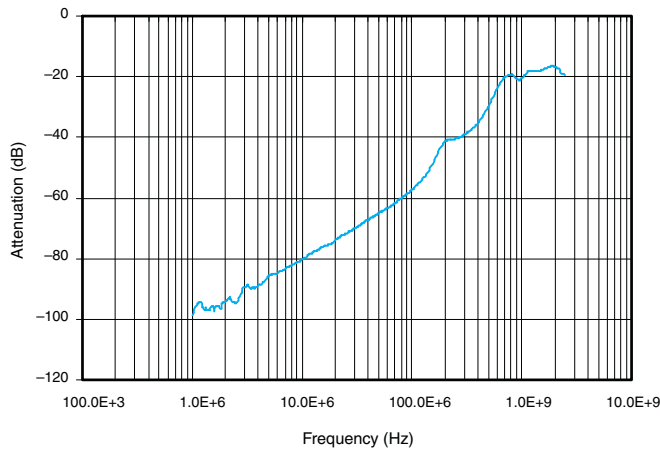


Figure 4. Crosstalk vs Frequency

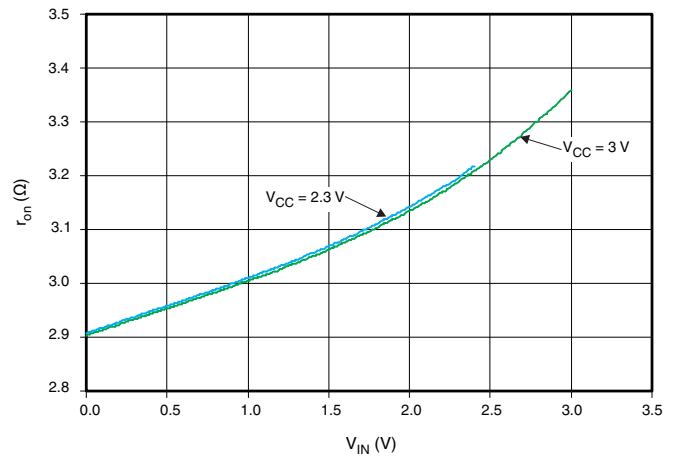


Figure 5.  $r_{on}$  vs  $V_{IN}$  ( $I_{OUT} = -15$  mA)

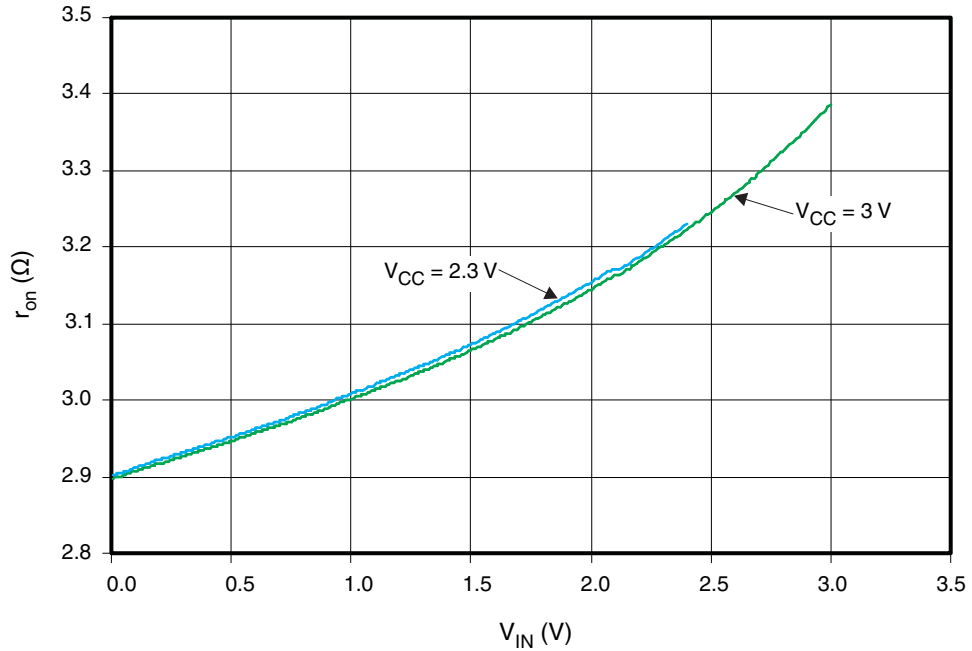


Figure 6. r<sub>ON</sub> vs V<sub>IN</sub> (I<sub>OUT</sub> = 30 mA)

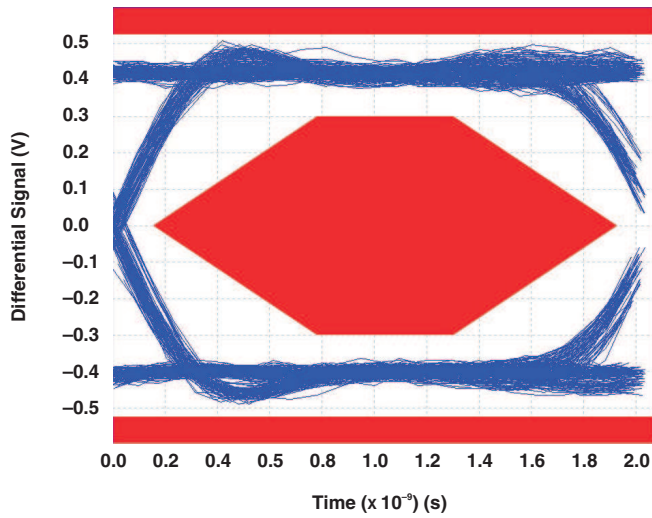


Figure 7. Eye Pattern: 480-Mbps USB Signal With No Switch (Through Path)

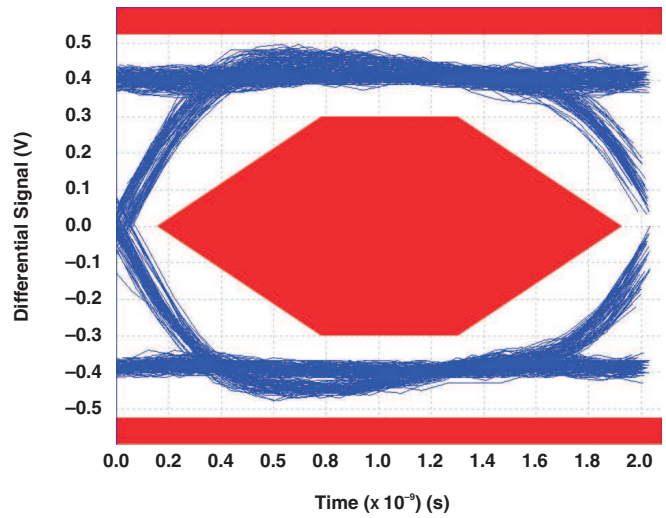


Figure 8. Eye Pattern: 480-Mbps USB Signal With Switch NC Path

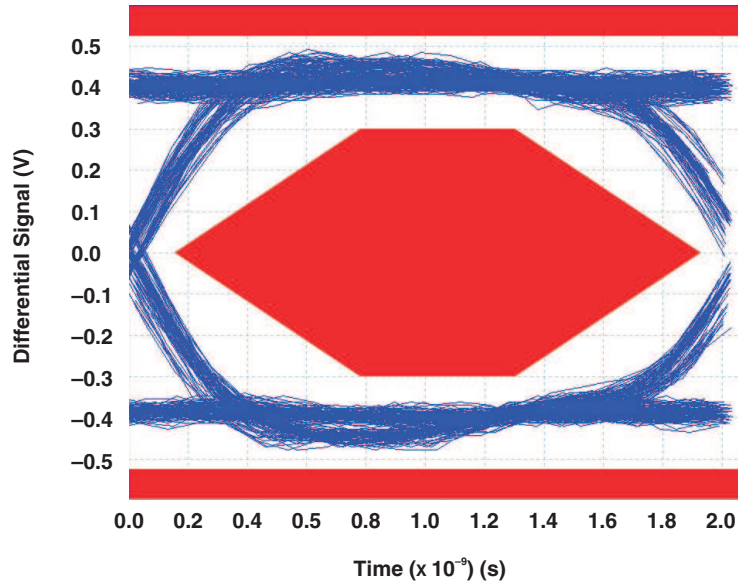
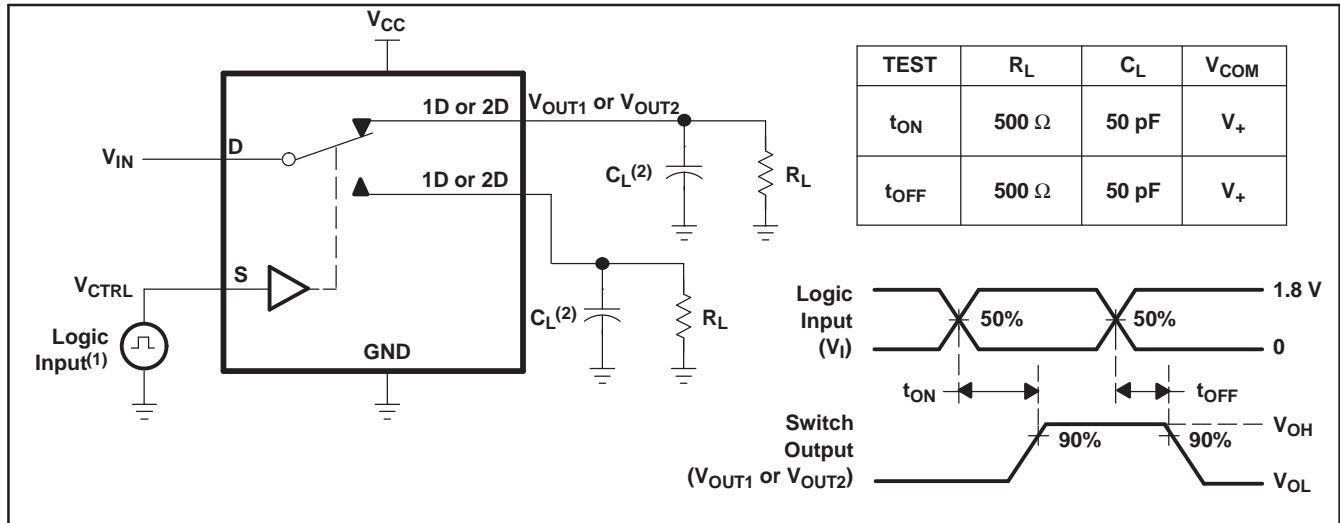


Figure 9. Eye Pattern: 480-Mbps USB Signal With Switch NO Path

Figure 10. Turn-On (tON) and Turn-Off Time (tOFF)

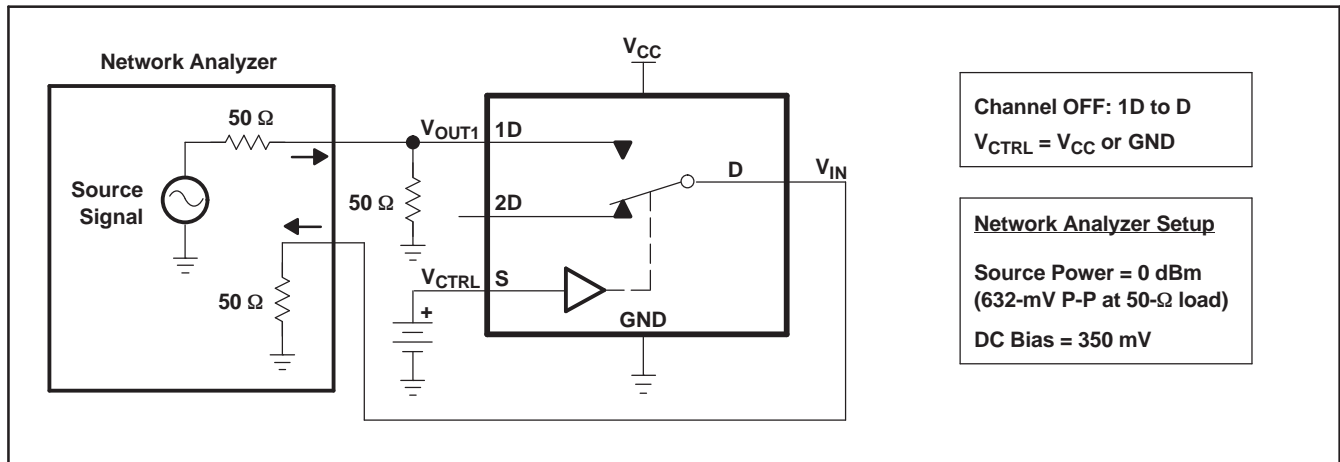
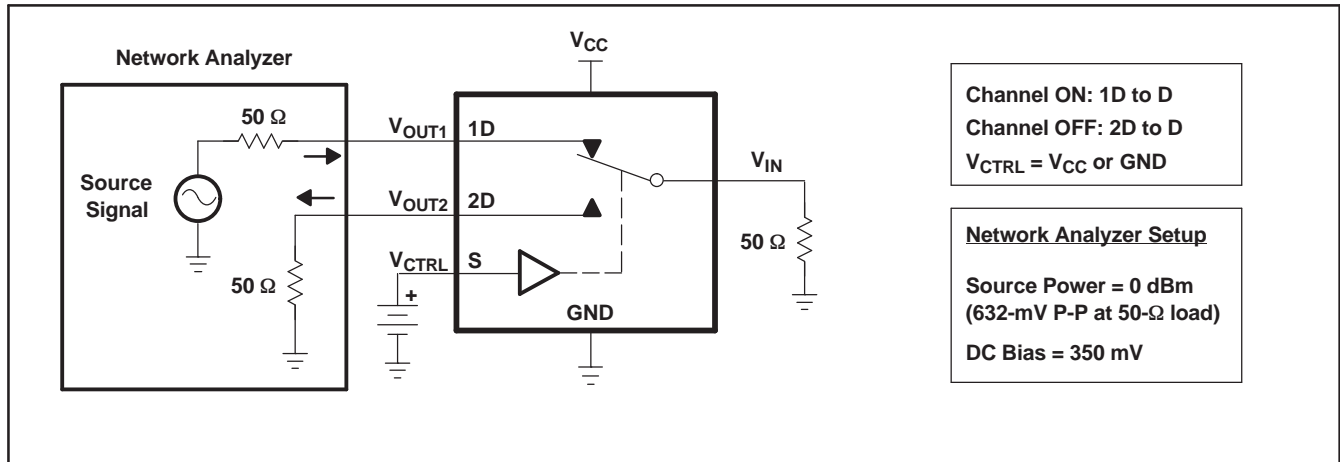
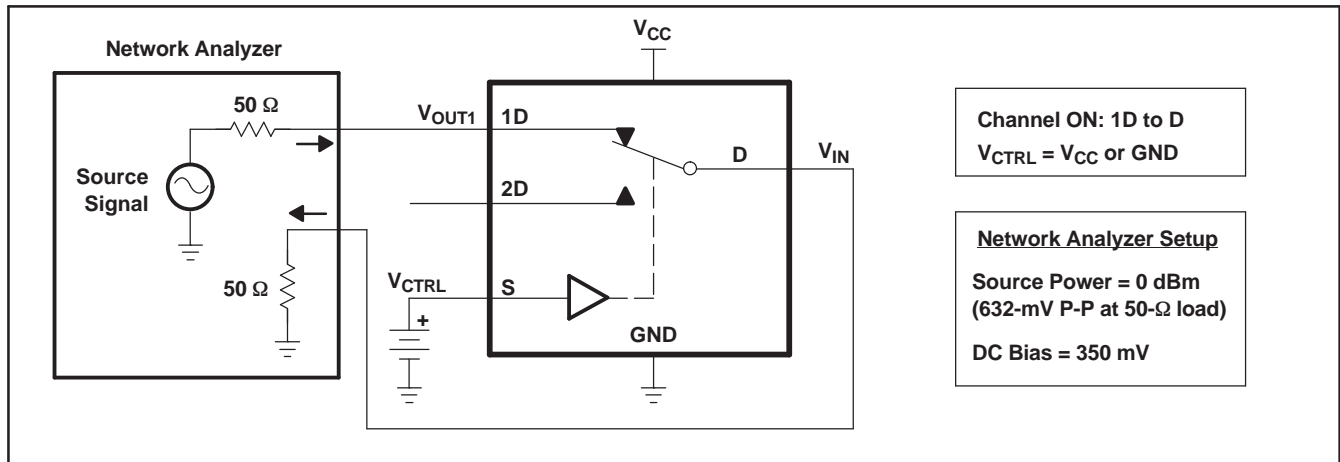


Figure 11. OFF Isolation (OISO)

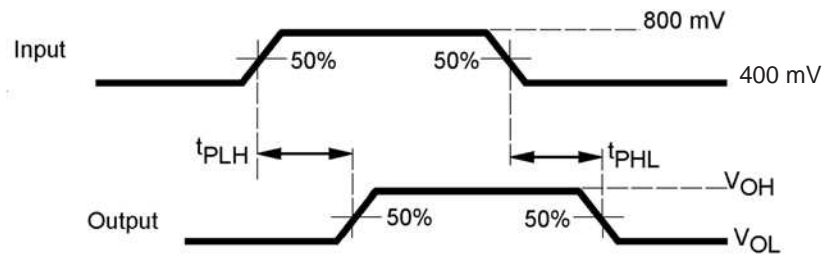

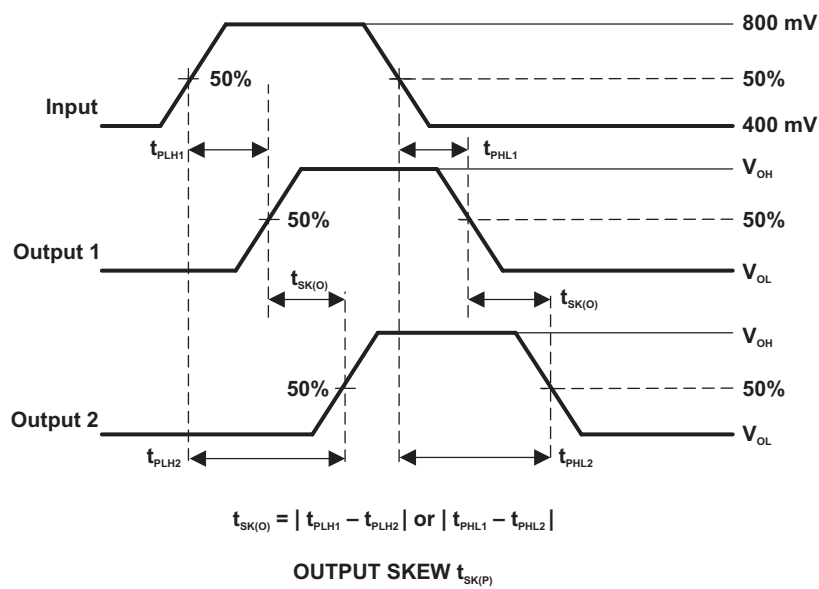
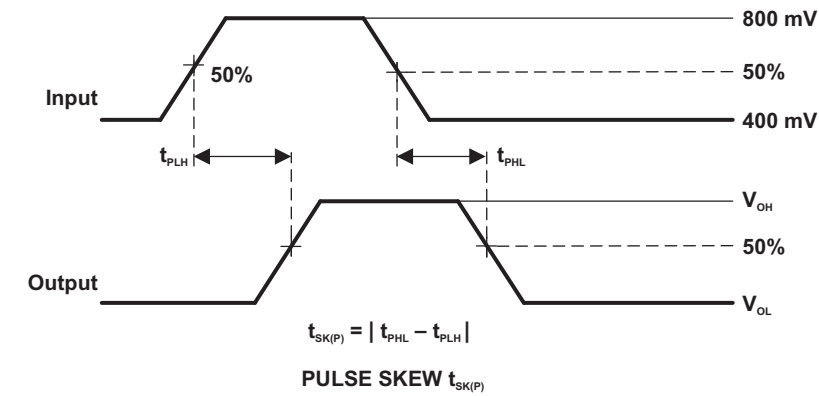


Figure 15. Skew Test

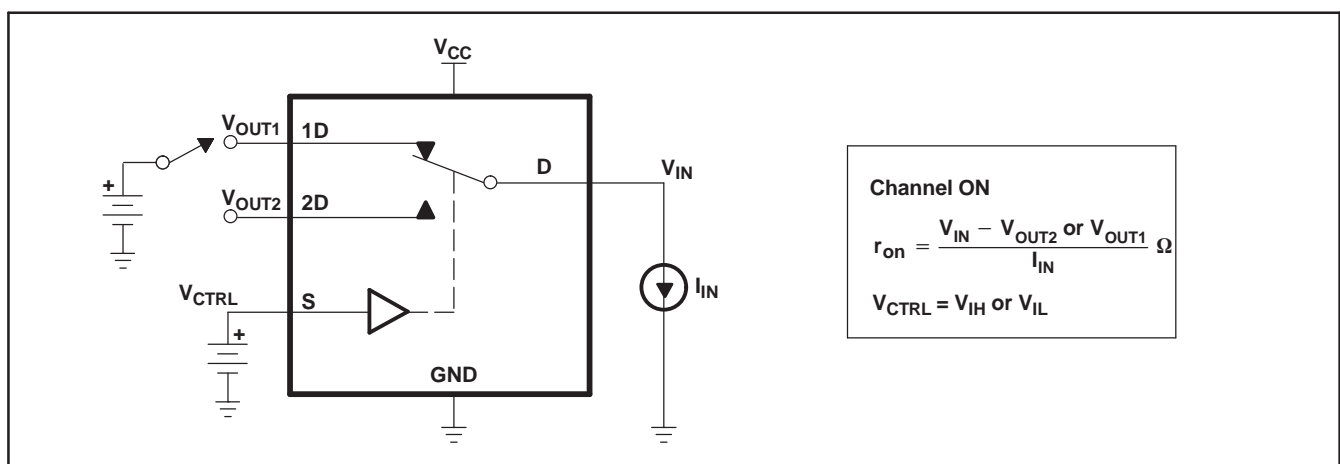


Figure 16. ON-State Resistance ( $r_{on}$ )

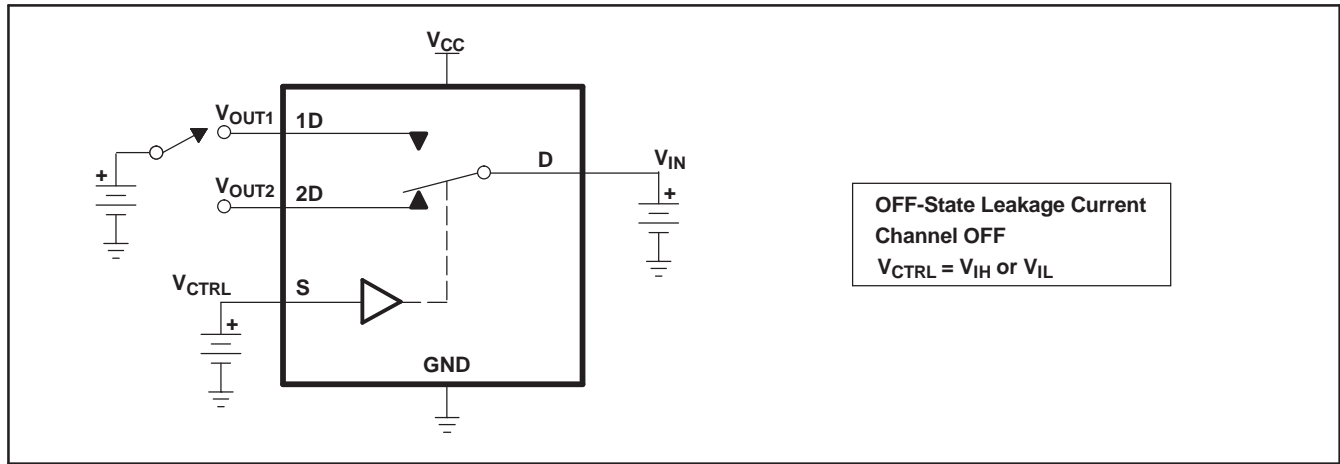


Figure 17. OFF-State Leakage Current

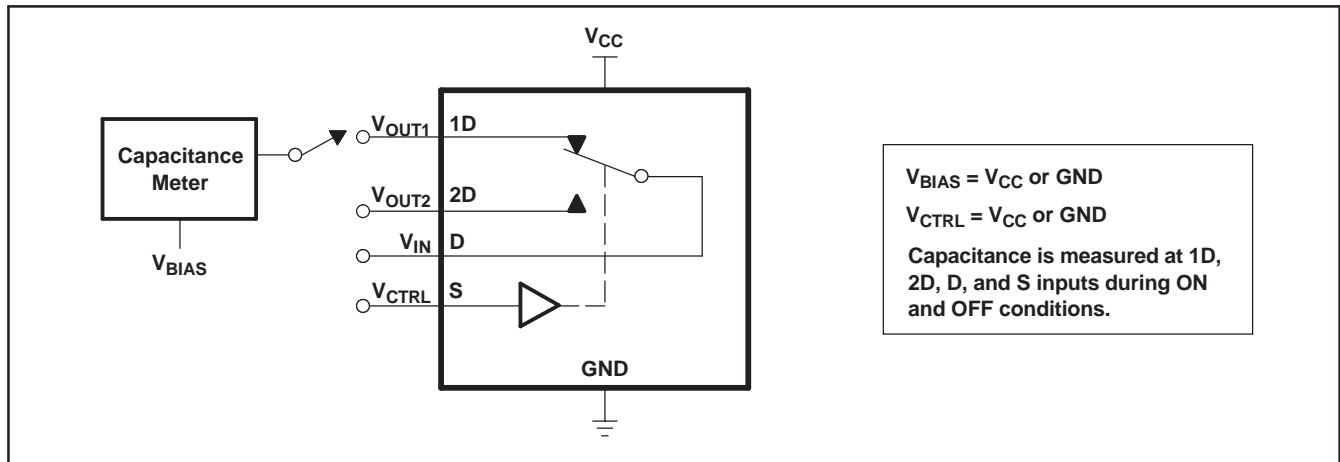


Figure 18. Capacitance
