## 1. General description

Logic level N-channel MOSFET in an LFPAK56 (Power SO8) package using TrenchMOS technology. This product has been designed and qualified to AEC Q101 standard for use in high performance automotive applications.

- True logic level gate with  $V_{GS(th)}$  rating of greater than 0.5 V at 175 °C

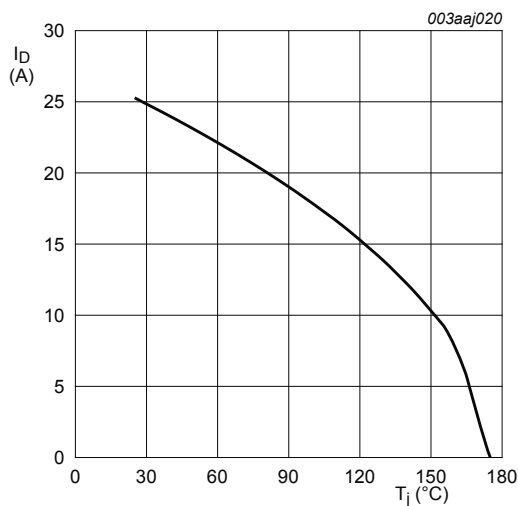

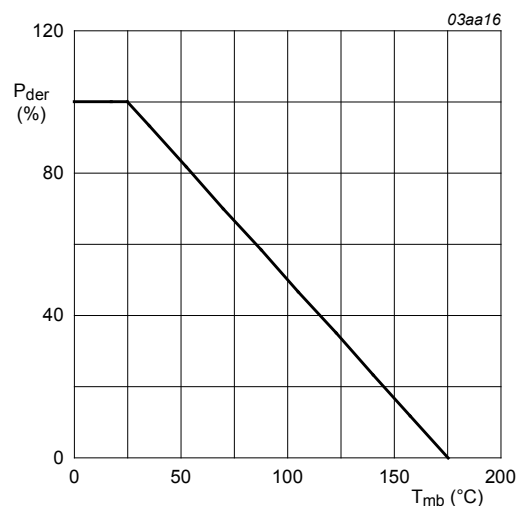

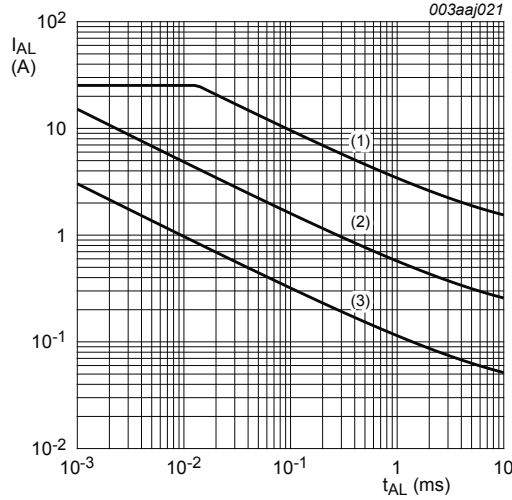
**Fig. 1. Continuous drain current as a function of mounting base temperature**

$$V_{GS} \geq 5V$$



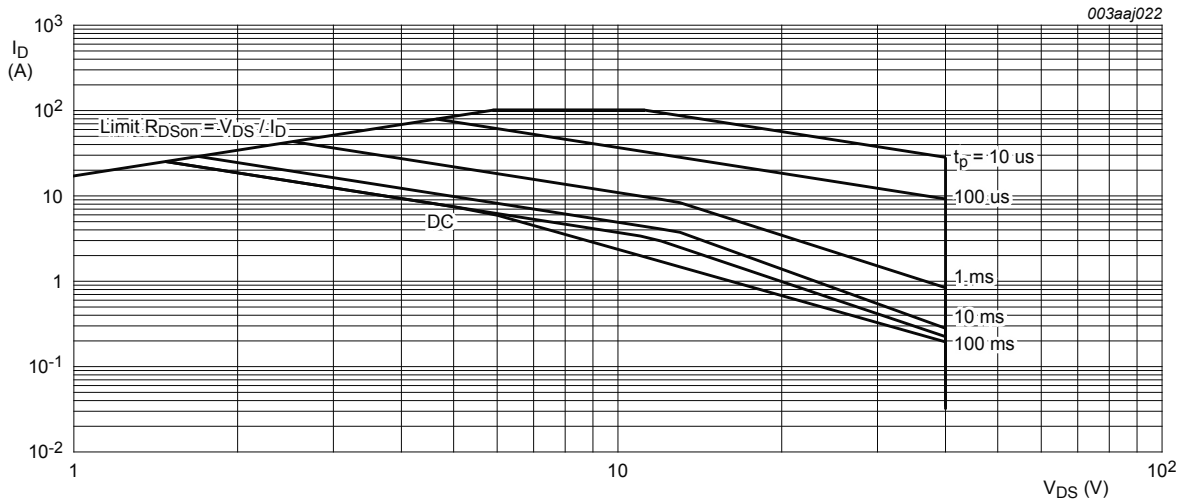
**Fig. 2. Normalized total power dissipation as a function of mounting base temperature**

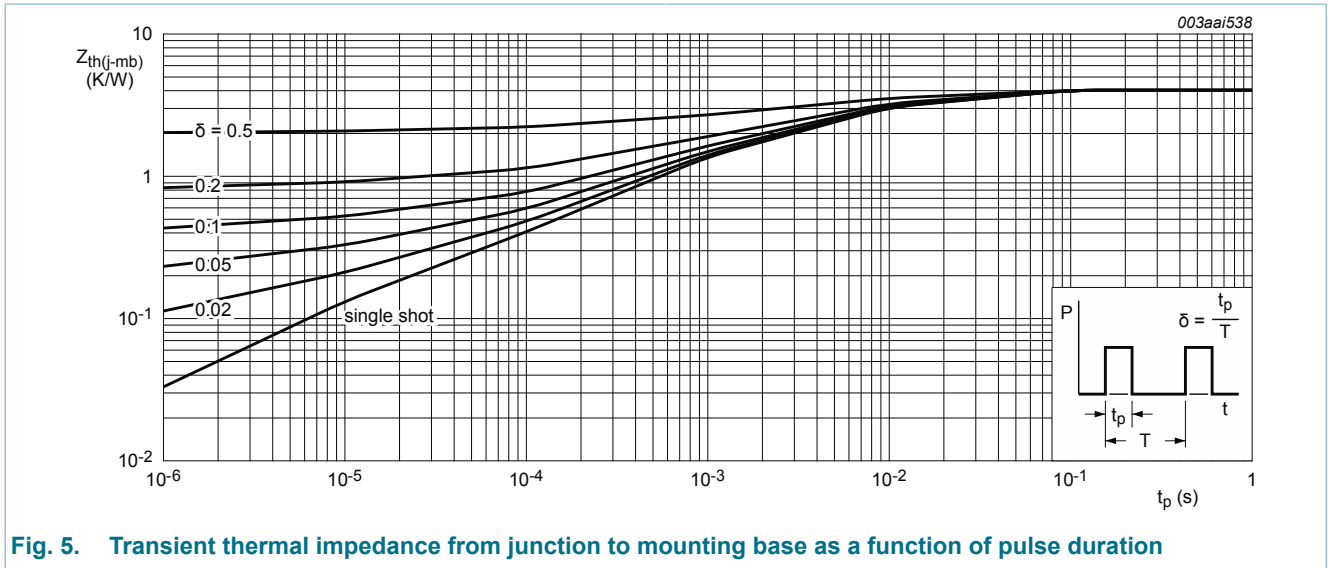
**Fig. 4. Safe operating area; continuous and peak drain currents as a function of drain-source voltage**

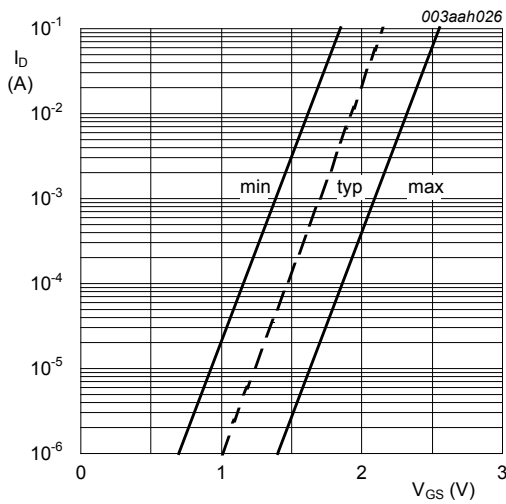
**Fig. 8. Transfer characteristics; drain current as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values**

$$V_{DS} = 10V$$



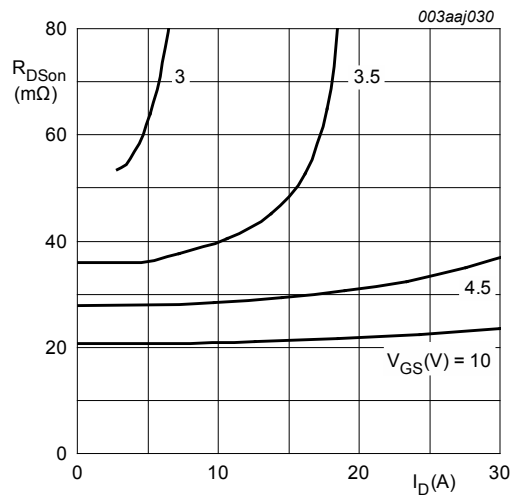
**Fig. 9. Gate-source threshold voltage as a function of junction temperature**

$$T_j = 25^\circ\text{C}; t_p = 300 \mu\text{s}$$

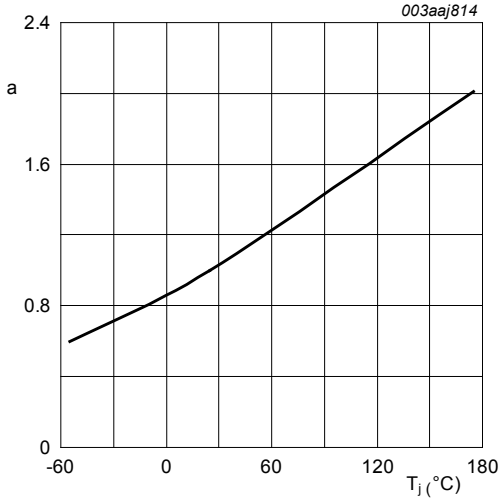


Fig. 12. Normalized drain-source on-state resistance factor as a function of junction temperature

Fig. 13. Gate charge waveform definitions

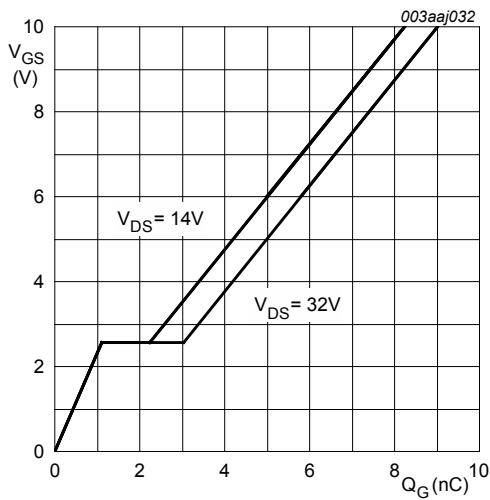


Fig. 14. Gate-source threshold voltage as a function of junction temperature

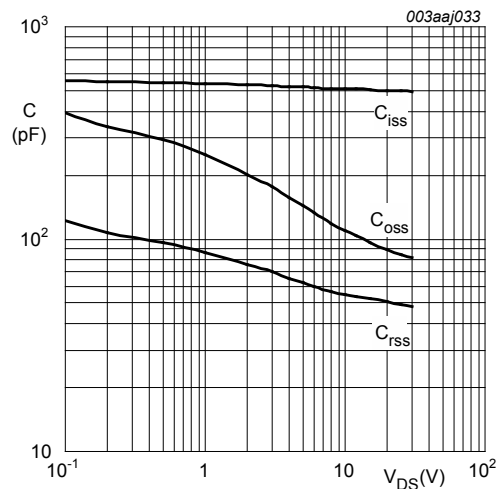


Fig. 15. Input, output and reverse transfer capacitances as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values

$$V_{GS} = 0V; f = 1MHz$$



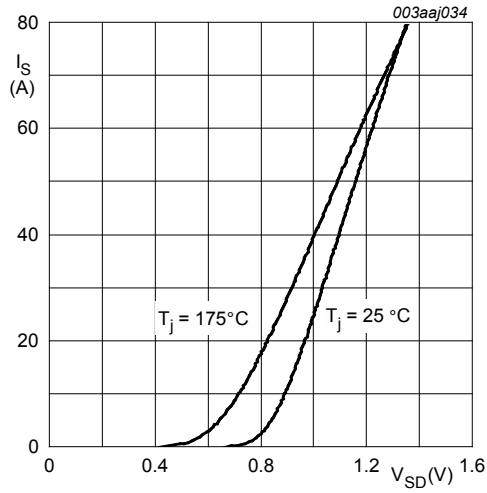


Fig. 16. Source (diode forward) current as a function of source-drain (diode forward) voltage; typical values
